




UNIFORM POLICY

At Redeemer Lutheran College, Biloela we believe that good grooming and a neat appearance are an essential part of the total person. Uniforms provide this neat appearance, and have the added benefit of creating unity within the student body. In addition, uniforms help to foster respect for organizational rules; they eliminate the possibility of clothing that distracts from the learning environment; and they allow students to maintain pride, give a positive impression and reduce competition and peer pressure.

All Redeemer Lutheran College students are required to wear the College uniform as approved by the College Council. The only exceptions to this policy will be students with special needs. E.g. special corrective footwear. Any requests for special consideration must go to the Principal.

Parents of Redeemer Lutheran College are expected to support the College’s uniform policy. Parents are encouraged to review their child’s dress prior to leaving home each day. Students who are not wearing correct uniform require a note of explanation from parents. If a note is not available a Uniform Violation form will be issued by College Staff.

Redeemer Lutheran College, Biloela Parents and Friends’ Committee provide all items of the College Uniform, except shoes, hair ties, togs and bike pants, in the College’s Uniform shop. This valuable service is provided through the generosity of volunteers keeping our uniform costs as low as possible and the quality of our uniform high. All compulsory College uniform items are to be purchased through the RLCB Uniform shop. Non laundered returns can only be accepted within 7 days of purchase.

Sports Shoes: Sandshoes of choice– mostly white with blue, grey or black trim and white laces. To be worn with Sports uniform only.

Socks: White with charcoal striped ankle sports.

Interhouse Sports: *(To be worn for Interhouse Carnivals – Cross Country, Athletics and Swimming only)*

A guide to wearing your uniform.

1. Primary students, Prep-Year 6, wear Formal and Sports uniform on designated days.
2. Secondary students wear Formal and Sports uniform as required by their timetable.
3. Red and Yellow House polo Shirts are only worn for Cross Country, Swimming Carnival and Interhouse Athletics.
4. Jumpers are not worn around the waist.
5. Dress length needs to be conservative for modesty. (No greater than 5cm from the ground when kneeling.)
6. Sandals are not worn with Sports uniform or with the winter options.
7. Sandals are not to be worn with socks.
8. Hats should be worn on the way to and from school, and during breaks and outside activities.
9. Formal Shirts need to be tucked in. This includes to and from school.
10. School uniform should be worn correctly out of school hours when students are in public.
11. Failure to wear the correct uniform requires a note.
12. No hat means outside play is limited. "Hat" means the correct College uniform wide brimmed hat or Sports hat. If students are not wearing a hat, they must play under the shaded eating area at morning tea and during lunch must be in the Library or in Banksia Place. Please check that all hats are named. When a child has forgotten or misplaced their hat, "Substitute" hats cannot be worn, with the exception during sport and P.E. Lessons. "Hat on outside, hat off inside". Children are not to wear baseball caps to and from school.
13. Students are required to wear correct uniform right up to the last day of the school year.

Please Note:

Our uniform is a significant part of our College's history. Therefore, there are elements of the school uniform that need to be retained when proposing or considering changes. The general design, fabric and colour of the formal uniform should remain intact. The College Council sets guidelines for uniform design and makes the final decision on any change to the College uniform.

Any review of the College's uniform is to be done in consultation with the Principal, staff, parents and students. While the uniform may constantly be under review, any major changes must have a 'life span' of at least seven years. Any uniform change must have a maximum one year 'change over' period.
