BLUE Intervention

Teachers manage all students' minor behaviours <u>unless</u> disruptive behaviour continues. Behaviour then gets GREEN treatment.

These Behaviours require intervention of Principal and report to parents if the behaviour is repetitive.

- Vandalism
- Computer misuse
- Extortion
- Swearing at staff
- Verbal abuse of staff
- Damage to property
- Graffiti
- Kicking
- Pinching
- Hitting
- Punching
- Stealing
- Indecent exposure
- Inappropriate touching
- Bullying (as per policy)
- Dangerous refusal to follow instructions
- Physical abuse of staff
- Bringing weapons to school
- Running out of school

These behaviours always require intervention of Principal and Parent.
