HIERARCHY OF BEHAVIOURS Minor Misbehaviours BLUE Intervention	HIERARCHY OF BEHAVIOURS Serious and continual Misbehaviours GREEN/RED Intervention
<p>Teachers manage all students' minor behaviours unless disruptive behaviour continues. Behaviour then gets GREEN treatment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pushing in • Telling Tales' • Being Cheeky • Wasting time • Being noisy • Making noises • Horseplay • Using swear words • Eating in Class • Eating in non assigned areas • Play fighting • Name calling • Attention seeking • Interrupting teacher • Avoiding work • Hitting back • Being rude • Running while indoors • Running on cement • Constant talking • Calling out • Unco-cooperativeness • Swearing • Talking Back • Pinching • Swearing • Lying • Refusing to do work <p>These Behaviours require intervention of Principal and report to parents if the behaviour is repetitive.</p>	<p>Bringing drugs to school</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Racial abuse • Vicious kicking • Vandalism • Computer misuse • Extortion • Swearing at staff • Verbal abuse of staff • Damage to property • Graffiti • Kicking • Pinching • Hitting • Punching • Stealing • Indecent exposure • Inappropriate touching • Bullying (as per policy) • Dangerous refusal to follow instructions • Physical abuse of staff • Bringing weapons to school • Running out of school <p>These behaviours always require intervention of Principal and Parent.</p>
